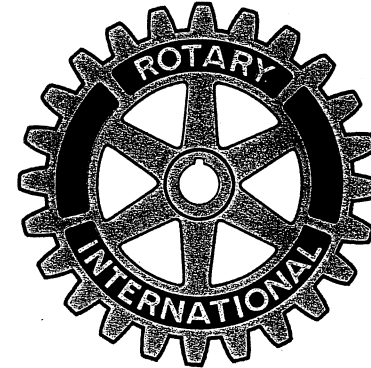

Roger told us about the white tigers on display at the Zoo. They will be there until October. Over 141,000 visitors came to the Zoo to see the gorgeous creatures from July through September of 1988.
