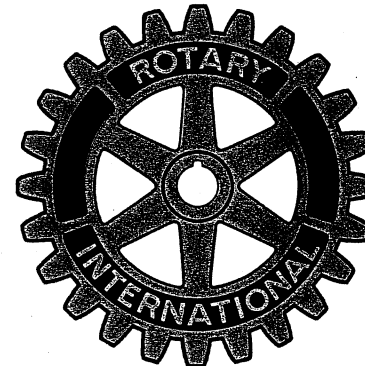

TODAY'S PROGRAM

For the second straight year, we are privileged to have Charles Billings as our special program for today. You will be overwhelmed at both the strength of his voice and the range. We are privileged to have Charles with us today. Charles is Jim Crone's cousin and this is why we are able to have him sing for us.

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

PROGRAM CHAIR DANA DAVIS was pleased to introduce Shelby County Attorney General Bill Gibbons as our speaker for the day. Bill, a Memphis Rotarian, and his wife Julia (Federal Judge) have 2 children. The oldest, a daughter, is in college in New York City and they reside in Mid-town.

Bill began by discussing our excessively high crime rate in Memphis. 110,00 new criminal cases were presented by the Shelby County Grand Jury. Of this, some 16000 indictments were presented to the Criminal Court.

The cause of most of the crime occurs as these people do not share the values of the majority of the population. There are 15 to 25 active gangs in the area which produce much of this crime. The other reason is related to drugs.

Bill spoke of how New York City was 10 years ago and how it is now. This lower rate is due to an active involvement by churches and service groups. One thing which has somewhat lowered crime is the Attorney General's decision to eliminate PLEA BARGAINING. This was an excellent presentation.
