

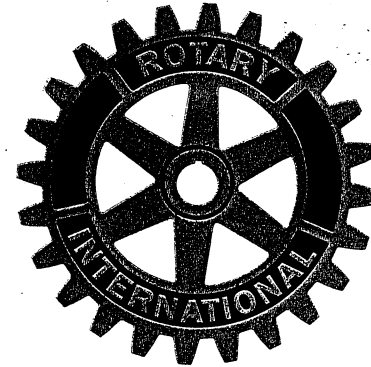

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Program Chairman Chris McDermott, introduced Howard Meagle as our speaker for the day. Howard is the General Manager of the WMC stations.

Howard made a timely address with the advent of the Olympics in Salt Lake City. WMC-TV was the first station to present programming in HDTV. Simply put, digital is the future of television. TV has been broadcast in essentially the same way since it was invented before World War II, but digital changes all of that.

The present frequencies now enjoyed by television stations will be sold to the wireless telephone industry and 2011 will mark the end of analog programming. You may purchase converters to continue using your present sets but this will be costly. At the present time, HDTV sets are expensive but the cost will be reduced by the numbers manufactured.

This was an interesting presentation and we have all been watching the Olympics although few if any of us have the full spectrum in HDTV.
