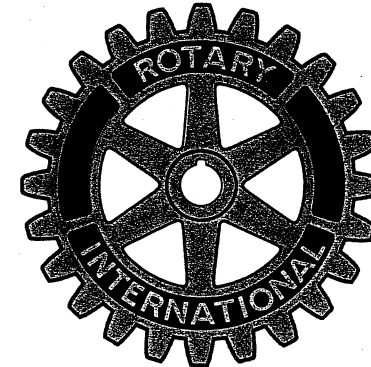

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Program Chair DANA DAVIS was pleased to introduce Jim Holt as our speaker for the day.

Jim Holt is the Executive Director of Memphis in May International Festival. He was hired in 1998 after the former director resigned, leaving MIM with an approximate \$600,000 deficit, the largest in the history of the organization. He has helped put MIM back on solid financial footing and directed the event successfully for two years in a row. The annual Beale Street Music Festival, MIM's biggest moneymaker, surpassed record numbers in attendance for 2000, the second year in a row.

Jim is 42 and is originally from Ohio. He has been in Memphis since 1979. From 1979 to 1993, he worked for Mid-South Concerts and served as its vice-president for 12 years. He has also worked for a Nashville music agency and ran his own promotion business for three years. Thanks to MIM, Memphis receives international recognition for its efforts. It is a \$6 M dollar event.
