

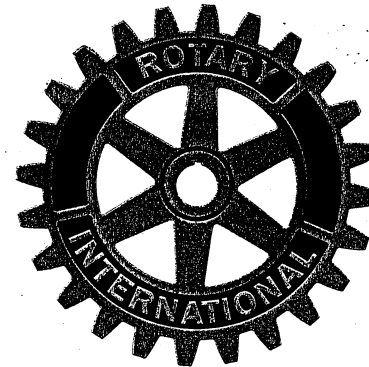

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Program Chairman Chris McDermott was pleased to introduce William Taylor, Associate Head of St. George's High School in Collierville.

Taylor is a graduate of Kenyon College in Ohio where he received his B.A. in history, Berkeley Divinity School at Yale where he received his Certificate of Anglican Studies and Yale Divinity School where he received his M.A. in Religion. He was previously the Associate Head of Trinity-Pawling School in Pawling, New York where he was for the past 12 years. He was also the varsity tennis coach at Trinity Pawling.

His office is located on the St. George's Day School campus in Germantown until the opening of the new Collierville campus in the fall of 2002. As Associate Head of the high school, he will create the upper school division to complement the new middle school and a second elementary school, all outgrowths of the highly respected 41 year old Day School. Taylor's primary challenges include recruiting outstanding faculty and staff, planning and overseeing the development of the rapidly growing upper school program, ensuring the development of an outstanding curriculum, marketing and promoting the school, and collaborating with the local community to broaden their involvement.

"The school's philosophy and mission resonates clearly and convincingly with my own self-awareness as an educator and school leader," says Taylor. "I feel fortunate and honored to be able to contribute to the exciting future of St. George's.

Bill's wife, Jennifer was the Director of Parent and Alumni Relations at Trinity. Their son, Wilson is 12 and will be in the seventh grade at St. George's. They also have a daughter, Allyson, who is 9 and will be in the fourth grade at St. George's. This was an interesting presentation.
