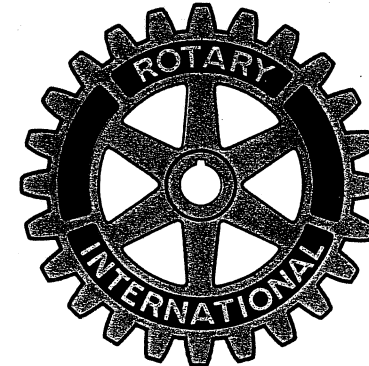

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

PROGRAM DIRECTOR DANA DAVIS was pleased to introduce Doug Daniel as our speaker for the day. Dog was born in Milan, Tennessee and moved to Memphis in 1960. He is retired from the U. S. Postal Service after 30 years. He is married to psychotherapist Laurie Daniel and has two grown daughters. He was awarded the prestigious Thomas Jefferson Award for Distinguished Public Service and the JC Penney Golden Rule award for exceptional volunteer service to the community in April of 2000.

Doug is speaking for WEVL radio(89.9 FM). In answer to the question of what is WEVL, he answered that it is diversity, unique radio for listeners with no commercials and it is VOLUNTEER radio.

The funds for its operation come from the listening audience which encompasses a radius of 50 miles. The call letters simply say, "We Volunteer." With only three paid staff positions, WEVL reflects the collective effort of numerous volunteers, both on and off the air. WEVL currently broadcasts daily from 6 AM to 2 AM (20 Hours) and has more than 70 different programs airing each week. This was an interesting presentation. Thank you, Dana.
